

- It would be meaningful to share how sponsorship has brought your family together. How it's opened different doors with talking to your kids about the importance of generosity and loving others.
- If you know there are other sponsors in the audience, recognize them by asking them to stand up. It will make your event even more effective if there's more sponsors people can speak with.

Support your presentation from the Scriptures

This is a good place to read a Scripture about the poor, poverty or caring for children. And share how your child sponsorship helps you understand it in a new light. (See page 8 for some Scripture ideas.)

Start to wrap it all up

You can reference the video and say, “Did you see how much the letters meant to the kids and how they called their sponsors Mom and Dad? Can you imagine a child living in poverty calling you Mom or Dad? What a great privilege! We have so much to share — our love, our prayers, our letters — the impact of sponsorship is real. In your life, and in the lives of children in need. As a child sponsor, you'll help show children who need to hear it the most that their lives matter.”

Save the call to action for the end ... and be clear

“If God is calling you to sponsor a child, I encourage you to go out to that sponsorship table [give the specific location] and find them, because there's a child there that needs you. You can start your sponsorship experience today.”

It would be good to hold up a few child packets at this time. You can even share their names, ages and the countries they're from.
