**06** Help me, Lord, as your chosen one, holy and beloved, to have a compassionate heart, to show kindness, humility, gentleness and patience, and to bear with everyone. *Based on Colossians 3:12-13*

**07** Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life. *Psalm 139:23-24*
