

# A WEEK OF PRAYER: ADORATION OF GOD

**PRAYER BEGINS WITH WORSHIP.** This month we are praying using the ACTS acrostic: **A**doration, **C**onfession, **T**hanksgiving and **S**upplication. Our focus this week is on adoration of God, taking time to appreciate our Lord and Savior with the help of Psalm 145!

**01**

Praise God because he is our Lord: "I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name forever and ever. ... Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom" (Psalm 145:1,13a).

**02**

Praise God because of his great works from generation to generation (Psalm 145:3-7). Recall two or three events from the story of Scripture that bring you to a place of awe.

**03**

Praise God that he is merciful: "The LORD is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love" (Psalm 145:8). How has God shown mercy to you?

**04**

Praise God that he is steadfast and unchanging: "The LORD is trustworthy in all he promises and faithful in all he does" (Psalm 145:13b). How has God been faithful to you?

**05**

Praise God for his care toward those who are facing hardship, such as children in poverty: "The LORD upholds all who fall and lifts up all who are bowed down" (Psalm 145:14).

**06**

Psalm 145:21a says: "My mouth will speak in praise of the LORD." What words come to you in praise of God today? You might read back over Psalm 145 if you need a prompt.

**07**

What characteristic of God stood out to you as you focused on adoration? Consider finding an object or picture that represents that characteristic to you and will remind you to worship God when you see it.
