




WE ARE LIVING IN UNPRECEDENTED TIMES










Pray specifically for leaders of countries in the developing world, that they will act with honesty and integrity. Ask God to soften their hearts and help them to be servant leaders.






Pray that in times of tension and even violence, world leaders will have a supernatural calm. Pray that they will make proactive decisions and serve those they lead well.


